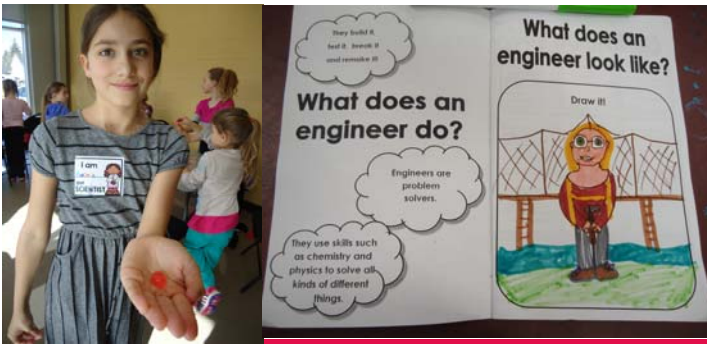
Girls Inc. gives girls ages 6-18 tools and resources to succeed.
